Endoscopy - guidelines for residents in PAC

Introduction:

Recommendations for Pre-anaesthetic Reviews:

<u>Endoscopy is generally a low-risk procedure and so referrals to PAC-Anaesthesia should be uncommon.</u>

<u>Please do not refer a patient to PAC-Anaesthesia without discussing with the Clinical Lead or another anaesthetist beforehand.</u>

A small number of patients may have complex medical problems where assessment and communication might be best facilitated via a PAC-Anaesthesia visits (eg cerebral palsy or motor neurone disease patient for PEG insertion).

Patients with end-stage or unstable cardiovascular or respiratory disease (eg severe COPD requiring home O2) may very occasionally warrant a PAC-Anaesthesia visit however this is very uncommon.
